Scrambling Tour - McDowell Preserve Rock

April 20, 2013

For the past decade I've been the Climber Liaison to City of Scottsdale Staff on the McDowell Sonoran Preserve and have been involved in the identification of what crags we can climb on and what the proper Climber Access Routes are. Along with 15 hearty members of the AMC and the Az Section of the American Alpine Club we took a hiking tour of the super rock climbing available in the Preserve. We started with a scrambling tour of Fort McDowell, Half and Half Wall, and Lost Wall. We then crossed the ridge past Lost in the Air and the Rist to Tom's Thumb and then went by Slip and Slide and Glass Dome. We summitted East End, the highest point in the McDowells and signed into the summit register. Afterwards we continued along the ridge and down by Hog Heaven. After some folks had to leave we caught Sven Towers I, II, and III. For most of the crags I was able to share dozens of routes and top rope set up locations. This information is not particularly available any where else.
